Although the home language is Spanish, it does not have to be a barrier, and we are open to receiving articles in other languages, with the aim of reaching a wider audience, although for the moment, our texts are published in Spanish and English.

- a. Title of the article
- b. Full name of the author
- c. Institution to which he/she belongs
- d. Email/social networks of the author
- e. A brief curriculum vitae (approximately ten lines) of the author

Articles should be in the following format:

Length for an article or essay of between 1500 and 3000 words.

Font should be: Arial

Font size, 12 points

Line spacing of 1.5 lines

Page size of 21.5 x 28 cm (letter size)

Margins of 3 cm on all four sides

The hierarchy of titles must be clear, as it will be the primary structure of the thematic

content. To do this, the hierarchy can be indicated with the following characteristics:

Title, in 14 points, will be in bold, upper and lower case, aligned to the center, leaving three

blank lines between it and the text that follows it.

Subtitles, in 12 points, will be in bold, upper and lower case, aligned to the left. Before a

subtitle, it is necessary to leave two blank lines, as well as a single line between it and the

text that follows it. The title and subtitles will be descriptive and brief (no more than ten

words).

If there is a title of lower hierarchy than the subtitle, it can be aligned to the left, with no

space between it and the text that follows it, using a size of 12 points and in italics.
